

Semester Project

Due January 6th

By the end of this semester, you will be required to present a semester project. You will be in groups of 4, and the focus is to creatively display your knowledge and application of the class thus far.

Requirements

- **An annotated bibliography of at least 5 sources.**

This is a bibliographic list of sources used with a short summation of the information gained from each source.

- **A 10-20 minute presentation.**

This will **NOT** be a lecture, but must be a creative application.

Some examples:

Write and perform a song and explain the words/music to the class

Write and perform a drama, dance or musical

Use the visual arts (like painting, drawing, etc.) to represent what we've been learning and explain to the class

Create a short video

The more creative, the better- this is not a comprehensive list

- **The topic(s) you choose will be redemptive-historical in nature.**

Trace an idea, either theological or literary, throughout the Bible. We will be covering a lot of these topics in class, but here are some examples:

Creation

Temple

Priesthood

Exodus

Ironic Justice

Covenants

Poetics

Remember: You will be required to submit your topic and list of potential sources by the end of September.
